We will work with every family to help obtain lessons, and in many cases, provide scholarships for them.

Options for Private Lessons

- Find a teacher on the Friends in Music list (pg 2 of handout) for a lesson rate of \$17.50/half hour
 - You will need to contact that teacher and set up a lesson time and location.
- Need-based Scholarship from Central Music Academy
 - You may apply for scholarship if needed on the attached application.
 - We will contact you about scholarships and set up a lesson time.
 - The student will be responsible for CMA's attendance policy and extra concerts.
- Find a teacher on the Fayette County Private Teachers list or local music store (Old Town/Hurst).
 - Cost of lessons will vary.
 - You will need to contact that teacher and set up a lesson time and location.
- Students with an existing private teacher may simply show documentation of their private lessons.
